Research Background

Curated by Susan Ballard and Aaron Kreisler, curator, Dunedin Public Art Gallery (DPAG), *Among the Machines* is a major exhibition of 13 leading Australian and New Zealand artists. 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Research Significance

The Dunedin Public Art Gallery is one of New Zealand's pre-eminent art galleries, and the exhibition took over 3 floors of the contemporary galleries. The exhibition was the outcome of the Dunedin Public Art Gallery international visiting scholar programme and received substantial funding from Creative New Zealand. Record visitor numbers attended the exhibition, which was accompanied by a substantial book/

catalogue and three months of coordinated public lectures and a visitors' programme including film premieres and school workshops. The book is a joint publication with the other visiting scholar Dr. Caleb Kelly (UNSW), and was launched at the City Gallery in Wellington, NZ.
