BULLI: In Counties Camden and Cumberland, electorate of Illawarra, police district Wollongong. Headquarters Bulli Coal Mining Company — coal extracted chiefly by tunnelling, shipped from jetty—

great length enables vessels draw in. Co. formed 1861 — first shipment coal 1863. Town reached by Wollongong steamer or rail to Campbelltown and thence by coach. Many well cultivated farms in district, land being held by free selectors. 11/6, p.20.
