“Click Go The Years!”

Elaine Mabbutt's work highlights photography as a source material for local history. The work represents photographs spanning fifty years of Berry's history, from 1875 to 1925, arranged so as to focus on the community's people, their origins and callings, their personal family and social activities and events considered by photographers to be of significance at the time.

For those wanting to know more of the history of Berry, it is a very readable account.
