

REPORT ON DECEMBER MEETING, 1997

Alick Osborne and the Adam Lodge

At the December meeting Frank Osborne delivered his talk on the above title, based on Alick Osborne's Journal of Occurrences Connected with Emigration, 1836-1837. This journal is located in the Dixson Library, where it is numbered MS 248 and may be accessed on microfilm CY 2294. Frank delivered an abridged version of his original article, the version which is published below. Copies of the more detailed article

have been lodged in two places: in the Local History section of Wollongong City Library and in the Kiama Family History Centre. Each copy is accompanied by other data on the Adam Lodge, such as full details of the families, lists of births and deaths, copies of historical documents, newspaper reports and a map of the route.
